OPEN LETTER
Responding to the Unprecedented Attacks on Poland
by The European Commission and Parliament

As members of the Polish Diaspora dispersed around the world, in vast majority, also being legal citizens of Poland and other countries forming the European Union (“EU”), with a growing disbelief, we are witnessing an unprecedented onslaught of aggressive rhetoric and a threat of unlawful actions to interfere with Poland’s internal affairs and ultimately its sovereignty, orchestrated by Brussels’ misguided officers of the European Commission and a circuit of biased German politicians along with their acolytes within the European Parliament.

Under the ludicrous guise of defending the Rule of Law, which is allegedly under attack from the democratically elected Polish Government executing its constitutional duties, the European Commission would go beyond grotesque in its attempt to acquire powers never granted to the EU by Member States. Such a tyrannical approach is readily visible and, as such, does not escape the public notice. Naturally, there is growing discontent among Member States. The Eurosceptic voices are intensifying with the pending British referendum.

George Washington said: “Arbitrary power is most easily established on the ruins of liberty abused to licentiousness”. The everlasting verity of that maxim applies to an arbitrary overreach “on the ruins of liberty” coming from Brussels that seeks to bully Poland into submission with evident marks of a contempt towards the Member State and disrespect to its Nation, including the accusations of supposed xenophobia, while in fact, the Eurostate’s database provides that Poles welcomed over 350 thousand migrants just in 2014!

How else, therefore, would we excuse the hysterical and hypocritical diatribes of Mr. M. Schultz, Mr. G. Oettinger or Mr. F. Timmermans (among others) against the duly elected Polish government’s internal reforms? Undeniably, Poland’s reforms fall OUTSIDE THE SCOPE of EU LAW and under observance of important national interests while upholding the existing constitutional framework. Alas, such a legislative effort was necessitated by years of corrupt rule of the Civic Platform allied with the post-communist oligarchy.

It is admitted verbatim that Member States never have bestowed on the EU powers regarding fundamental rights and other constitutional principles existing in their own legal orders. Hence, the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights applies exclusively in the field of implementing European law by Member States. In other words, no “Kompetenz”, paraphrasing Mr. F. Timmermans!

Notwithstanding those provisions, or rather deeming them a dead letter, Brussels’ bureaucrats seek rescue for extension of their powers into “the special mechanism” of Article 7 of the EU Treaty, which may lead to the suspension of Member State’s rights, including its voting rights in case of “a systemic threat to the rule of law”. How will they ascertain such a threat on the ground? As we observe today, the European Commission seeks to facilitate dubious political controversies originating from the goals of the voter-rejected oligarchy that follows the old Stalinist motto: “the power once gained we will never relinquish”. By and large, the complacent

Western media, without questioning repeat, false enunciations, are trampling over their ethics and responsible, objective reporting.

It suffices to state that the threat of rights suspension under Art. 7 of the EU Treaty has never been exercised before in history, especially, under the seemingly unrestricted discretion of Brussels' bureaucracy. Symptomatically, the same bureaucracy is unable or unwilling to ascertain basic facts and adequately react to pressing issues affecting the entirety of the Union, such as the destabilizing Europe migration crisis or Russia and Germany's strategic alliance under the Nord Stream II agreements, which indisputably violate European solidarity as well as the imposed international restrictions, as primary examples.

Hence, Poland's newly manifested sovereign self-confidence came to light as an apparent causation of the EU's victimizing threats.

The whole scheme is alarming even more, since it is fueled by a handful of arrogant German politicians partnering with a few other misguided individuals and German media, including those owned by German interests in Poland (representing, as of today, approximately 80% of the Polish press market). Therefore, their so sudden (and exclusive) sympathy to the partisan causes of the neo-leftists and post-communist oligarchy in Poland that loses its iron grip on "the spoils of power", unravels as a gross bias, all the more, that Poland's actions have no effect on private media.

Inevitably, common sense and painful lessons of history evokes the familiar demons of the past, notably, Prussian 18th-century belligerent imperialism and 20th-century German Nazi crimes against the Polish State and Nation.

There are unintended (for the perpetrators) and good (for democracy) consequences arising out of this. The Polish Diaspora is awakening and will react to any and all reprehensible attacks on Poland in due course.

Regardless of the results of the coming meetings of the European Commission and European Parliament debating "the situation "in Poland on January 13th and 19th, we condemn in the strongest possible terms the ongoing, convoluted interference into Poland's internal affairs and thus its sovereignty. Furthermore, we call upon the Member States of the EU to manifest their solidarity and stop a dangerous and undue precedent in its tracks.
